An (Invite-Only) FTN Underground Message Network

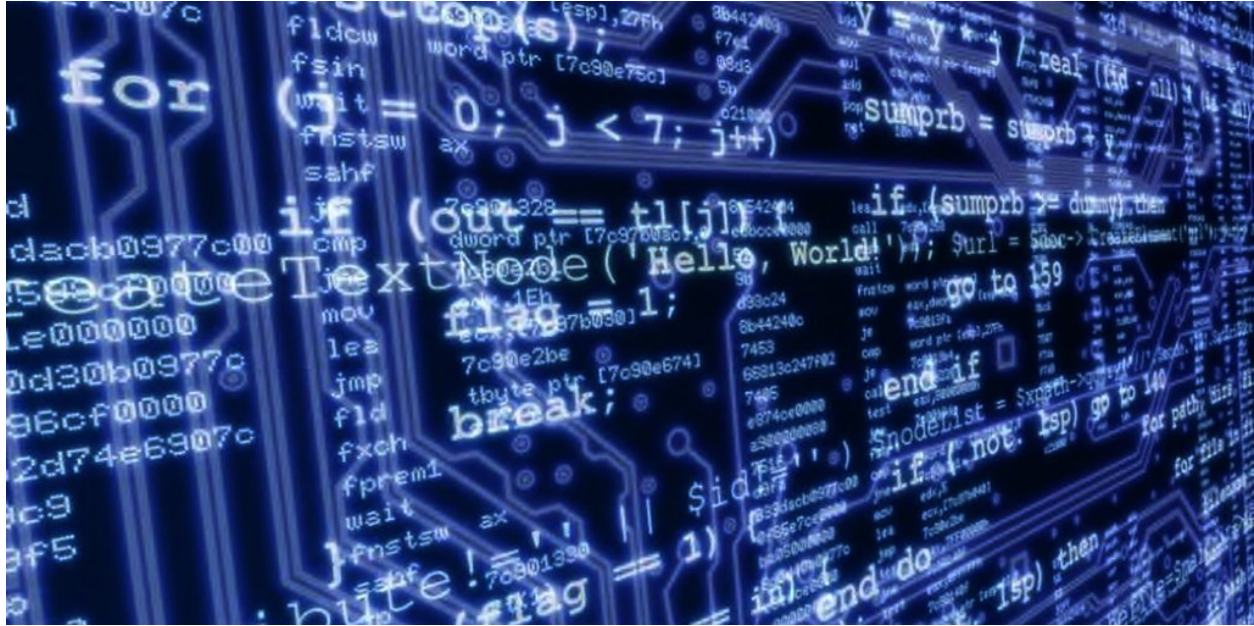

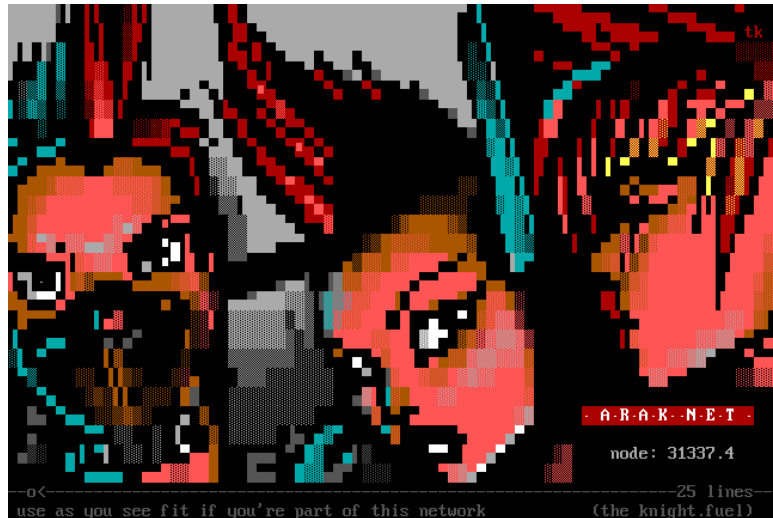


{THE UNDERGROUND ART SCENE} BITS and BYTES



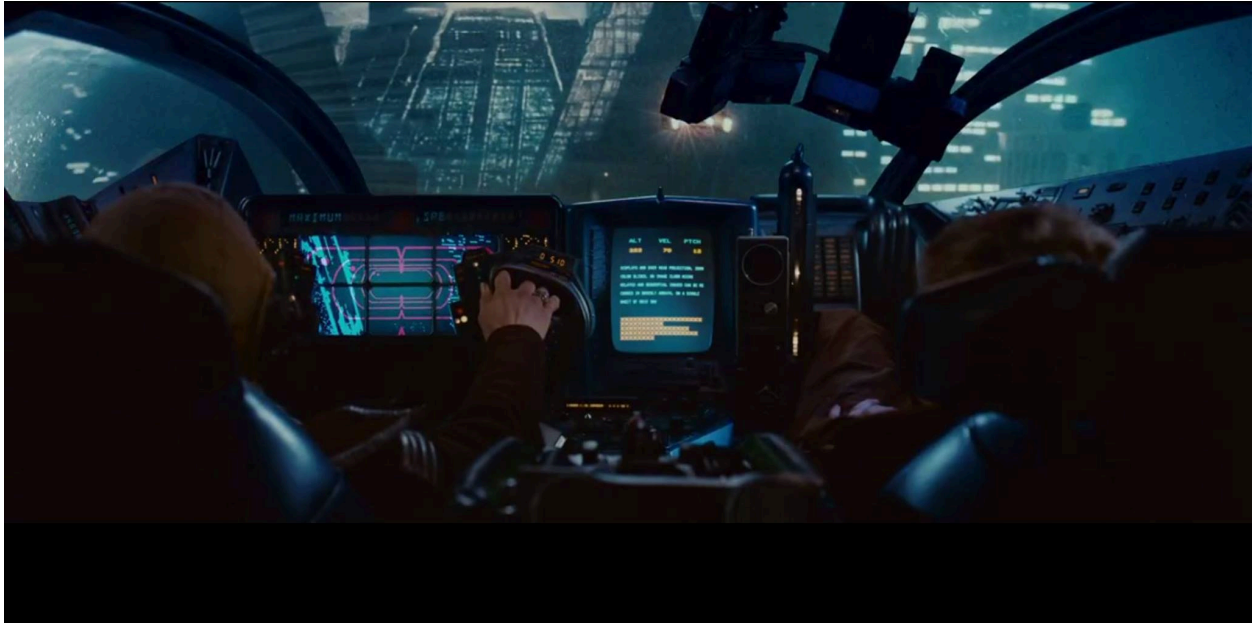
